


#### GENERAL INFORMATION

Lamar State College of Technology is a state supported college located in the heart of industrial Southeast Texas at Beaumont. The principal industries in the area are oil refining, shipping, ship building, rubber manufacturing and other related industries. Rice farming and ranching are the chief agricultural pursuits.

The campus is situated on a 75-acre tract facing the Beaumont-Port Arthur Highway in Southeastern Beaumont, Texas.

The city of Beaumont has a population of approximately 120,000 with adequate schools, shopping districts, churches and transportation to satisfy the needs of a thriving industrial community.

#### Accreditation

Location

Lamar is accredited by the Association of Texas Colleges and the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools. In addition, the Departments of Chemical, Electrical, and Industrial Engineering are accredited by the Engineering Council for Professional Development.

#### Library

With seating room for several hundred students, a reference room, a film supply room, a microfilm reader room, subscription to more than 400 periodicals, and almost 60,000 volumes combined with a budget of sufficient size to increase the volumes by several thousand per year the library is not only adequate now but also has an assured future for excellent service to students and faculty alike.

Library hours are 7:45 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. Monday through Thursday, 7:45 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Friday, and 2:00 to 5:00 p.m. Sundays. Closed Saturdays and holidays.

#### Health Center

The college maintains a Health Center for the use of students who become ill during the summer session. This center is located on East Virginia Street near the dormitories.

The types of service available are: 1) out-patient service for those who have minor ailments but who do not require constant supervision, 2) infirmary service for those who are in need of continued attention of the College physician or registered nurse.

#### Teacher Certification

Any person who enrolls for the first time in a program leading to certification for teaching at any elementary or secondary level should consult the dean of the School of Education.

#### Bookstore

The bookstore is self-supporting, owned by the College, and operates in the Student Union Building in addition to its own building.

#### Graduate School

Graduate courses are offered in English and in History.
Interested persons should see the department head concerned.

Testing and Placement Service Placement assistance is provided at the Testing and Placement Office in Room 102, Liberal Arts Building. Mr. Joe Thrash is director of the center.

Summer School Commencement A student who completes all the requirements for any degree at the end of either term will have the degree conferred during the summer commencement scheduled for Saturday, August 26.

Other Academic Regulations The general regulations of the College also apply to the summer session. Students are urged to read details of these regulations in the current catalog.

The College requires all students to live in one of the College dormitories and to take their meals in the College dining hall.

The only exceptions to this regulation are: 1) Students who live with parents or relatives.

2) Married students who live with their wives or husbands.

3) Students whose health conditions demand special service.

4) Students whose part-time employment conflicts with College meal service hours.

Summer session students are housed in the ultra-modern dormitories. Rates for room and board may be found under the Fees and Expenses section of this Bulletin.

Reservations To reserve a room in the dormitory, direct a request to the Dean of Student Life, Lamar State College of Technology, Beaumont, Texas. A check for \$20 must accompany the reservation request. Room reservations may be cancelled with full refund until three weeks prior to the first day of classes. No refund will be made on concellations received after this date. Dormitory residents will be refunded deposits, less any breakage charges, at the end of the year. If a student moves from a dormitory at any time other than the end of the term, the \$20 deposit will not be refunded.

Class Attendance and Absences Since class periods are longer and classes meet every day in the summer session, regular and punctual attendance is especially important. When absences are unavoidable the student is obliged to keep the instructor informed of the reason and the course should be dropped if the absences exceed 15% of the number of class meetings (about one week).

Cancelling Courses The College reserves the right to cancel all courses with insufficient enrollment (less than 10 persons). This is often done for sections of a given course but rarely has it been necessary to cancel a complete course.

#### THE SUMMER SESSION

The summer session is a part of the year-round program at Lamar. The faculty is composed of regular staff members with the library, all classrooms, and all laboratories available for full use. Course credits are the same as for the long session. The summer session serves many groups:

1) Entering freshmen

ì

Adjustment to the College study pace is easier during summer because there are less distractions and study time is spent on two subjects every day.

Students with deficiencies in any field but particularly in engineering and in science are urged to make up these deficiencies during the summer.

Other students may accelerate their graduation date by summer study.

2) Student who work

Students who must work while attending college may take courses to reduce study loads or to make up for light loads during the regular session.

Transient students.

Students in other colleges or professional schools may remain at home and attend the summer session to take certain needed courses.

4) Students who fail courses

Students who have failed to pass certain courses, who are on probation, or who are suspended may attend the summer session without penalty. This does not apply to students who have been suspended from other

#### Admission

A new student, whether a freshman or a transfer, must meet all the entrance requirements.

A regularly enrolled student may attend the summer session without restriction except in load carried.

A transient student (a student at Lamar for the summer session only) may present a letter of good standing without a transcript. Students suspended from other colleges may not attend the summer session or any session until the suspension status is lifted.

#### Student Load

No student may register for more than 8 semester hours in a given term or for more than 14 semester hours for the complete summer session, except that a senior scheduled to graduate at the end of the current summer may register for a maximum of 15 semester hours for the whole summer session.

#### HOW TO ENTER LAMAR

# If You Have Graduated from High School

- Make application on regular form.
- Have transcript mailed to: Dean of Admissions Lamar State College of Technology, Beaumont, Texas.
- Have your doctor complete a health certificate and mail in your own stamped envelope addressed to: Dean of Admissions, at the above address.
- 4. Take admission placement test at a convenient and early date.
- If you do not plan to live at home send your dormitory deposit (\$20.00) with request for space to Student Life Office, Lamar State College, Beaumont, Texas.

The above steps should be taken as soon as you decide you may want to attend Lamar. Application and health certificate forms may be obtained from the Admissions Office.

- 6. Report at time and place assigned by the Admissions office.
- In the meantime, read the current catalog so that you can be familiar with the program of study you wish to follow.

# If You are Transferring from Another College

- Study "Admission by Transfer from Another College" in the admission section of this catalog to be certain that you are eligible for admission to Lamar.
- Follow the same steps outlined for those entering directly from high school except that you must request each college attended to send your transcript of credits to the Dean of Admissions.

### If You Did Not Finish High School

- Study "Admission by Individual Approval" in the admission section of this catalog to determine your eligibility for consideration for admission by individual approval.
