ADMISSIONS PROCEDURES
POST MASTERS (PM), NON-DEGREE SEEKING
U. S. Citizens and Permanent Residents Only

For Students Who Have a Masters Degree and Wish to Enroll in Graduate or Undergraduate Courses, and/or Seeking Teacher Certification or Want to Enroll in the Superintendent Academy

- Definition:** The Post Masters (PM) classification carries undergraduate status, does not culminate in a graduate degree, and should not be considered as a means to enter graduate school. The PM admissions category is designed primarily for students who do not intend to earn a graduate degree but wish to enroll in graduate courses. Individuals who are applying for a teaching certificate or the Superintendent Academy will be classified as PM, but it must be understood that PM status does not lead to a master's degree.
- Admission:** To receive the PM classification, the applicant must: **A)** Have received a Masters degree from an accredited institution; **B)** Submit an application for admission with PM status to the Graduate Admissions Coordinator; **C)** Submit an official transcript from the college showing the masters degree earned; and **D)** Be approved for admission with PM status by the University.
- Enrolling in Courses as a PM Student:** PM students are not to enroll in graduate courses without the prior consent of the chair of the department offering the course(s). PM students are not permitted to enroll in graduate business courses.
- PM Students are not eligible for competitive Graduate Scholarships and Assistantships.**
- \$25 Application fee required unless graduated from LU within two years of application.**
