

Dr. Brenda Nichols is Dean of Arts & Sciences at Lamar University. In her role as Dean, Dr. Nichols guides the work of more than 200 full-time faculty in 12 academic departments, interdisciplinary majors, AFROTC, dual credit programs, study abroad and partnership programs at the undergraduate and Master's level. She oversees 48 budgets in excess of \$40M for approximately 5500 majors. Dr. Nichols has previously served as Chair, School of Nursing at Old Dominion University and as Founding Dean, College of Health Sciences at Southern Cross University in Australia. She graduated from the University of Evansville and earned a doctoral degree from Indiana University in 1983. Dr. Nichols was recognized as the "Most Inspiring Faculty Member" by the Outstanding Graduate for the College of Health Sciences at Old Dominion in 1992. She has served as a consultant to a number of educational institutions and hospitals. Her community activities have included work on breast cancer, civic and hospice boards.
