Lamar University's **Bachelor of Arts in American Sign Language** with a concentration in **interpreting** prepares you for teaching in schools offering ASL for “foreign language” credit in an EC-12 program. Each student must complete a required departmental core of courses, which includes ASL, interactive interpreting, sign-to-voice interpreting, etc. Each student will complete the pedagogy courses required for licensure. The program is offered only on-campus and will gain documented proficiency in ASL, validity within the deaf community and networking opportunities within the professional community.
