Lamar University's **Bachelor of Arts in American Sign Language** with a **teacher certification** prepares you for teaching in schools offering ASL for "foreign language" credit in an EC-12 program. Each student must complete a required departmental core of courses, which includes teaching ASL as a second language, clinical teaching, managing early childhood classroom environment, etc. In addition, each student will complete the pedagogy courses required for licensure.
