LIT students entering LU Program must have earned a "C" or better in ENGL 1301, ENGL 1302, MATH 1314, MATH 1342, BIOL 2401, BIOL 2402, BIOL 2421*, PSYC 2315, NUTR 1322 and all RN-BSN core courses to be accepted and progress in the program.

LIT students entering LU Program must have completed an AAS in Nursing or ADN or a diploma in Nursing from an approved program.

LIT students entering LU Program must have proof of current unencumbered license to practice professional nursing in the United States or approved United States territory.

*Microbiology requirement - LU will accept BIOL 2420 or BIOL 2421.
