

EVOLVE REACH, POWERED BY HESI ADMISSION ASSESSMENT TEST

TO BE TAKEN WITHIN SIX MONTHS OF APPLYING TO THE NURSING PROGRAM

- The Evolve reach powered by HESI Admission Assessment Exam (HESI A²) is a timed, computerized test that consists of seven academic exams: reading comprehension, vocabulary and general knowledge, grammar, basic math skills, biology, chemistry, and anatomy and physiology.
- The HESI Admission Assessment Exam (HESI A²) test costs \$53 to take.
- Students must earn a **79%** or higher on the **Reading Comprehension** section of the HESI Admission Assessment Exam in order to be considered for admission.
- Students may only take the HESI Test **ONE** (1) time for each application period. Students receiving a Reading Comprehension Score of less than **79%** on the exam, will be allowed **one** retake of **THIS** section in order to qualify for admission to nursing program.
- Students may sign up to take the HESI Test on the Lamar University Career and Testing Center's website at <http://www.lamar.edu/career-and-testing-services/testing/index.html> by clicking the HESI option under Administered Examinations. Students can call the Career and Testing Center at 409-880-8878 for further information.
- In order to schedule to take the HESI at any other location, you will need an Evolve student account. If you do not have one, you can create one at <https://evolve.elsevier.com/>. You will be required to enter your Student ID (issued when the student account is created) and the Lamar University School of Nursing ID (197020) when registering to take the exam. Please keep in mind that if you take the HESI at another location, that you are responsible for taking all of the required components of the test (see below).
- If you are applying for Fall admission: testing dates are from November 1st to March 1st.
- If you are applying for Spring admission: testing dates are from July 1st to September 1st.
