

**Kevin B. Smith, Ph.D.**, is a Professor of Sociology. He has served Lamar University for more than 37 years. During the late 1980's and early 1990's, he was department chair and he returned as interim chair in 2011--12. During his tenure at Lamar, Dr. Smith also held the positions of Associate Vice President for Academic Affairs, interim Vice President for Academic Affairs, interim Vice President for Student Engagement, and Senior Associate Provost. He teaches courses in social psychology and social stratification. Dr. Smith has also taught research methods, survey research, marriage and the family, statistics, social theory, and principles of sociology. Though administrative duties consumed most of his time, his research interests and publications have examined cognitions that support social class identification.
