Proficiency By the end of the semester, the majority of the students must make a minimum of 44.8 out of 64 points (or 70%) on the six-week unit plan. DO Benchmark By the end of the semester, the majority of students must make a minimum of 51.2 out of 64 points (or 80%) on the six-week unit plan. **Results of Assessment** All KINT 4310 students (10 out 10) met the minimum criteria of scoring 80% or greater on the six-week unit plan. This course was only taught during the Spring 2024 semester. The average score was 61.5 and the median was 63 (out of 64 points). The class average was 80.21% and the median grade was a 100. There were 14 students total that were eligible to take the exit exam for the 2023-2024 school year.
