Las year, the CPCE requirement during practicum was removed to lessen the stress of a standardized exam on students. Practicum students enrolled in Practicum in Fall 2024 and Spring 2025 performed well. Students must attend weekly one-hour long site supervision with a licensed professional at their practicum site, as well as weekly one-hour university supervision with their practicum instructor. 2 hours of total supervision on a weekly basis allows students to receive the support needed and prevents ethical and professional issues. University supervisors maintain bi-weekly contact with site supervisors.</p>	<p><i>No actions have been added.</i></p>
