### Course highlights Since Last Report

- In looking at the critical thinking and teamwork/society data from three previous years, we decided (as a pilot program) to add in a short (5 to 6 page) paper that reinforces critical thinking in those areas (Goals 3 & 4). See below--
- In spring 2023, we added a short paper/learning module assignment to the course TO reinforce critical thinking skills. This new assignment relates to critical thinking and film (Goal 3) and critical thinking and teamwork/society (Goal 4).
- The 5–6-page papers (from the pilot program) were of high quality and reflected an increase in film/society-related critical thinking and application. We are hoping that some students will present their papers at the Office of Undergrad Research student conference.
- As a result of this pilot program (and the data from all of the SLO assessments), we will be changing our assessment instruments (to better measure our goals and reinforce teaching strategies) for 2023-2024.
