## Respond here:

Chiefly, upon state demand we are offering remediation as a co-enrolled course. Students without proper test scores must take ENGL 1301 (our first comp course) with an ENGL 0301 Integrated Reading and Writing (non-college credit remedial course) We tried our own holistic testing to place students in stand alone ENGL 1301. We tried allowing students to choose their own ENGL 1301 and a ENGL 0301. Covid and new tests created the need for far more radiation. So we try to get students into and ENGL 1301 and then take a follow up 0301 with the same instructor as a lab course. All students are in both classes. We also created a non-credit bearing lab for students enrolling late.

We are just now getting data. The students whom we wholistically tested and waived from remediation had the best pass rate of English 1301 and 1302.

In spring of 2023, we collected essays from stand alone and co-enrolled sections of English 1301. We wanted to see if our efforts were producing like outcomes. So we assessed on written communication, critical thinking, and personal responsibility.

**Conclusion:** there is little difference between co-enrolled English 1301 classes and stand-alone English 1301 classes. The problem is the completion rate. We cannot measure that rate here. But in terms of quality we should proceed with our system.
