CRITERIA FOR STUDENTS:	GRE Policy
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Complete online application and pay a one-time application fee of \$25. * Official transcripts from all colleges/universities attended* <p>* Undergraduate GPA of 3.0 (institutional or last 60 hour count) or undergraduate GPA of 2.5-2.99 GPA (institutional or last 60 hours) or higher with corresponding GRE. Students who do not have a 3.0 GPA (institutional or last 60 hours) must have a qualifying GRE score within the first 9 credit hours. Students required to take the GRE must meet the institutional GRE and GPA standard. GRE taken after August 2011: Undergraduate GPA (cumulative or last 60 hours, whichever is higher) $\times 50 + GRE$ Verbal + GRE quantitative $=/ \text{ or } \text{ greater than } 428$.</p>
