Parking permits for this event are included in this packet. Please affix the colored permit visibly on your dashboard. The provided parking permit grants access to parking in ANY lot. The nearest parking lots are C-1, C-2, T2, T3, J-4, and E-1. Lots T2 and T3 will be reserved for this event, with a shuttle service running to and from the Setzer Student Center.

BEFORE PARKING use the circle drive outside the Setzer Student Center, located between the building and lot C-1, to unload your items with a College of Engineering representative. I've marked the circle drive with a red star in the image above.

FROM I-10/69 NORTH Take 69 South. Exit at Lamar University/MLK Parkway. Merge onto MLK Parkway. At the first traffic light turn left onto Florida Avenue (Jim Gilligan Way). Proceed through the first stop sign at Rolfe Christopher Drive. Turn right at the next stop sign onto Jimmy Simmons Blvd. and continue through two more stop signs. Turn right into parking lot C-1.

FROM DOWNTOWN/MLK PARKWAY Take the Lamar University exit and turn right at the stop sign onto Lavaca. Turn left at the next stop sign onto Jimmy Simmons Blvd. Turn left at the second median into parking lot C-1.

FROM MID-COUNTY/69 SOUTH Take 69 North. Exit at Lamar University/MLK Parkway. Merge onto MLK Parkway. Take the Lamar University exit and proceed through the first stop sign. Turn left at the second stop sign and proceed through the next stop sign onto Lavaca. Turn left at the next stop sign onto Jimmy Simmons Blvd. Turn left at the second median into parking lot C-1.

Upon your arrival, a representative from the Student Engineering Council or an Engineering Ambassador will welcome you and furnish you with a venue layout plan as they accompany you to your designated table. Individuals wearing a **red LU Engineering polo shirt** will be readily available to assist you at any time throughout the day.
