Lamar University - AAPA PPM Credit Policy:

In addition to completing the 132 hours of AAPA PPM curriculum, the prospective Lamar University Master's student must submit their:

1. Final AAPA capstone industry white paper or
2. A synopsis of their AAPA Industry-specific project or
3. The Executive summary with lessons learned and best practices of their "residency" at a Port other than their place of employment

to the Executive Director of the Lamar University Center for Advances in Port Management (CAPM). The Director and another CAPM faculty member will review the work and provide an oral examination prior to assigning the student credits.
