EMERITUS STATUS NOMINATION FORM

The title of emeritus may be conferred on retired members of the faculty and administration who have given faithful and distinguished service to the University for ten or more years and who are specifically recommended to the President (*Professor Emeritus, Associate Professor Emeritus*) and, in some cases, to the TSUS Board of Regents (*Distinguished Professor Emeritus, Distinguished Associate Professor Emeritus*). Their names are carried in the General Catalogue until death. For complete descriptions as well as nomination and approval criteria, please consult pages 13-14 in Chapter II of the Faculty Handbook. (Note: The president may bestow an appropriate emeritus title upon other retired, ranked faculty provided that they have served the institution for a cumulative total of at least fifteen years.)
