

## **Salary Spread Election Form**

Employees with a nine month assignment may be eligible to spread their salary evenly over the 12 month fiscal year by completing this form. Once elected, the salary spread arrangement is irrevocable for the remainder of the fiscal year. It will remain in effect for future fiscal years until canceled or until the employee becomes ineligible. Nine month faculty and staff who do not elect the salary spread option will be paid over nine months. For additional information, please refer to Human Resources Policy 2.28.

To be eligible to elect salary spread, the following conditions must be met:

- The employee must hold a regular, full-time, nine month appointment (Sept. 1-May 31),
- The election form must be received in Payroll before the first official class day of the Fall semester, and
- The employee's position is not funded in any part by Restricted Funds.

<ul> <li>The salary spread election cannot be changed during the 12 month period unless the employee's assignment is terminated or the funding is changed to restricted funds. If the termination is submitted prior to August 31, the balance of the salary spread due will be paid off in one payment on the first available payroll following both the termination date and receipt of terminating paperwork in the Human Resources Department. The size of the payment could result in an inflated tax deduction.</li> <li>To change the election, notification must be made prior to the first official class day of the Fall semester.</li> </ul>
