

## Le Grand Bal Art Auction Entries are OPEN!

We are happy to announce our annual Friends of the Arts Le Grand Bal Art Auction. This silent auction supports Art & Design students and will be held in conjunction with Le Grand Bal 2026, "50: A Sparkling Celebration of the Golden Anniversary of Le Grand Bal," a major fundraising event to support fine arts student scholarships and other educational opportunities in the College of Fine Arts & Communication.

This year's auction will be held at the **Setzer Student Center** on **Saturday, March 21st from 6:30 PM to 10:00 PM**. Some selected works will be exhibited online from **March 16<sup>th</sup> – 20<sup>th</sup>** for presales (*To be considered for presales, please submit your entry form no later than March 4<sup>th</sup>*)

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### HOW TO ENTER ARTWORKS

- **LIMIT:**
  - **2D WORKS-** Artists may enter up to **3 works** under **36" x 36"** **OR** **2 works** under **48" x 48"**
  - **3D WORKS-** Artists may enter up to **3 small scale sculptures** under **24"x24"** **OR** **1 large scale sculpture** under **36"x72"**
    - **Note:** Preferably works should be from the same series and not previously shown in the auction.
- **ENTRY FORM:** All artists must complete the online entry form by scanning the QR code below or by visiting [lamar.edu/lgbart](http://lamar.edu/lgbart).
- **DROP OFF\*\*:**
  - March 5<sup>th</sup>, March 6<sup>th</sup>, March 9<sup>th</sup>, 10:00 AM – 4:00 PM, Setzer Student Center
    - **ALL WORKS MUST BE READY TO EXHIBIT. 2D works must be wired and ready to hang; 3D works must be stable and on proper support. Only works that are ready to hang will be accepted**

\* If you need assistance, forms can be filled out at drop off.

\*\* If you are NOT a current employee of Lamar University, you will be required to turn in a completed W-9 form at this time. If you did not fill it out in advance, we will have copies available for you to fill out.

**ATTENDING THE AUCTION:** Your participation in the auction would be a wonderful contribution to this important cause. As an artist contributing work to the auction, you will have the opportunity to attend the auction and showcase your art. Please arrive by 5:00 P.M. to check in and receive your nametag. Only ticket holders may attend the formal fundraiser dinner.

### PICKING UP ARTWORKS:

- Unsold works will be available for pickup at the Setzer Student Center Ballroom Sunday, March 22<sup>nd</sup> from 1:00PM-5:00PM and Monday, March 23<sup>rd</sup> from 8:00AM-5:00PM. Artists **must** pick up unsold works from Setzer Student Center Ballroom by Monday, March 23<sup>rd</sup>. After this date, Artists can pick up their works from the Art & Design Office, Rm. 100. Please call the Department of Art & Design at (409)880-8141 if you need assistance.
- Payment for **SOLD** artworks will be processed 4-8 weeks after winners have collected the work and submitted payment.
