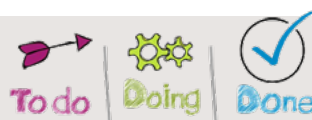

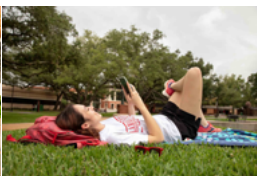

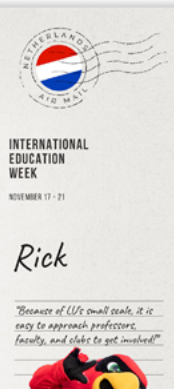
Celebrating Honors International Scholars Rick and Jacob

Hailing from Skanor, Sweden, Jacob is a candidate to graduate Lamar University in Fall 2025 with a Master of Engineering Science in Industrial Engineering. His Master's Thesis, "The Relationship Between Anterior-Posterior Ball Position and Golf Swing Wrist Kinematics in Elite Golfers," utilizes statistical data analysis, with tools such as MS Excel and Python, to investigate sports biomechanics trends in golfers based on different golf shot types.

Research

Turtle Parasites, Mosquitoes, & Modern Dance Research by McNair Scholars

Had a great time learning from Natalie, Jenny, and Sergio! The trio presented their research at the McNair Scholars Research Symposium last month.

They shared the latest findings on: local studies of turtle parasites (**Natalie Dickens**); presence of West Nile and other arboviruses in mosquitoes in subtropical coastal Jefferson County (**Sergio Mendez**); and how studying modern dance movements can help prevent injuries (**Jenny Tu**).

Biology Students Present Research at ABRCMS Conference

Biology senior **Sergio Mendez** and junior **Brandon Billot** traveled with Dr. Ashwini Kucknoor to share their team's research at the Annual Biomedical Research Conference for Minoritized Scientists in San Antonio.

After analyzing results in *Aedes* and *Culex* species from 2024, Sergio, Brandon, and their research team found positive samples of mosquitoes carrying West Nile, Chikungunya, Dengue, and Zika virus in Jefferson County.

Texas currently does not have a statewide mosquito control program. Brandon and Sergio hope the positive samples from their research will encourage the state to implement a year-long mosquito control program that would focus on the prevention of these infections before they become more devastating.
