All students must enroll and pay tuition and fees for both program courses (eight credit hours total) at the undergraduate or graduate level in Summer 1 2017. In addition, the travel fee of \$3,500 must be paid on scheduled installment dates. To make your deposit, you will pick up a 'Study Abroad Payment Slip' from the Office of Study Abroad in Wimberly 215. The slips can be found on the table by the door. You will use the payment information to fill it out.

Program travel fee payments are non-refundable upon acceptance into the program. Academic issues that will result in removal from the program without refund of program travel fee payments include: 1) Not maintaining a cumulative GPA of 2.00 at the completion of the Spring 2017 semester; 2) not having completed all program pre-requisites ('C' or better in BIOL 1406 & 1407) prior to the start of the study abroad program; and 3) not attending pre-travel program meetings and pre-travel lectures in May Mini-session (see below). Dropping the courses once registered, either intentionally or due to non-payment, will remove you from the program without refund of travel fee payments. If students withdraw from the program after receiving the Study Abroad Fee Grant, those funds will be owed back to Lamar University.								
During the spring semester there will be mandatory group meetings called by Dr. Hoch or the Office of Study Abroad to review travel plans, logistical issues, and pre-departure orientation to prepare students for a rewarding experience in Belize. Although you will be enrolled in the program courses for Summer Session 1, the Lamar University campus lectures will begin during the days of the May Mini-session, May 15 – 31, 2017. Classes during the May Mini-session will meet from 8:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m Our travel dates are set at June 5 – 19, 2017.
