Scholarship	Eligibility
Boren Scholarship	<p>Summer</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Min. of 8 weeks - Science, technology, engineering, mathematics (STEM) - Work for government after graduation <p>Semester/Year</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - U.S. citizen - At least 18 years or older - Applying to a program outside of Western Europe, Canada, Australia, or New Zealand
Freeman-ASIA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - US citizen or permanent resident - Must receive need-based financial aid or demonstrate need for financial assistance - Undergraduate student - At least 2.8 GPA - Must have at least one term of enrollment remaining at home institution, upon returning from study abroad - Eligible Countries: Cambodia, China, Hong Kong, Indonesia, Japan, Korea, Laos, Macao, Malaysia, Mongolia, Philippines, Singapore, Taiwan, Thailand, Vietnam - Must spend at least 8 weeks for a summer term or 12 weeks for a semester term - Little to no prior experience in country - Previous recipients are not eligible

The US-Japan Bridging Foundation	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Undergraduate - Study for a semester or year - Must earn credit at home institution - Must be accepted in a program in Japan and provide tuition - Demonstrate financial assistance
CJS Foundation Foreign Language Scholarship	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Silver or Gold Award Girl Scout - 3.0 GPA - Provide proof of acceptance with a study abroad department

DAAD German Exchange	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Undergraduate - Will be a junior or senior at the time of study in Germany - Will be studying for a 4-10 month period (1-2 semesters) - Well defined study, research, or internship plans - Enrolled in US institution full-time
Tortuga Backpacks	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - US citizen, resident, or on a student visa - Fulltime undergraduate student - Accepted into program

Scholarship	Eligibility
Asia Institute	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Engineering students - Studying abroad in Asia - Anywhere from 10 days to an entire year
Rotary Foundation Global Scholarship	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Graduate students - Coursework or research for one to four academic years - Areas of focus: Peace and conflict prevention/resolution, Disease prevention and treatment, Water and sanitation, Maternal and child health, Basic education and literacy, and Economic and community development - Applicants may NOT be (1) a Rotarian; (2) an employee of a club, district, or any other Rotary entity, or of Rotary International; (3) the spouse, a lineal descendant, or an ancestor (parent or grandparent by blood) of any person in the forgoing two categories
Toshizo Watanabe Study Abroad Scholarship	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Undergraduate or Graduate students - U.S. citizen - Semester or year-long study abroad program in Japan - Demonstrates financial need for international study - Applicants who have been raised by a single parent or who have lost both parents (Preferred) - Applicants without significant international travel or study experience (Preferred) - The priority for the scholarship is undergraduates who are studying abroad for a year or less
