Strategic Priority #1: Engage

What Are Our Goals?

1. Enhance marketing and visibility of library
2. Develop collaborative partnerships
3. Enhance information literacy instruction & research support.

How Will We Do It?

- Tell People About Us
 - Create a marketing plan that includes an event calendar and advertising venues.
 - Publish stories (e.g., social & campus media) on library resources and services.
 - Publish annual library impact report.
 - Publish dashboards and/or infographic templates to retrieve and share data.
- Spread the Word on University Archives & Special Collections
 - Report on survey of collections.
 - Publish revised Records Management Policy.
 - Create instructional content related to record management (e.g., videos).
 - Create social media posts to promote University Archives & Special Collections.
- Bolster Our Partnerships
 - Create list of current partnerships and potential new partners.
 - Create a Library Coordination Team from groups sharing the library building.
 - Increase communication with complementary units
- Targeted Event Planning
 - Host more faculty focused workshops.
 - Develop needed assessment.
 - Meet with campus groups to identify gaps and opportunities for collaboration.
- Solidify Instructional Outreach
 - Use existing and new to improve services.
 - Create an annual outreach schedule for academic departments.
 - Create a contact list of online programs and their faculty.
 - Summarize online student and faculty support.
- Define Student Success
 - Look at peers and best practices for assessing student research success.
 - Launch annual faculty surveys on perceived student research skill improvement.
- Support Our Students
 - Enhance library presence in Blackboard.
 - Distribute a virtual faculty toolkit each semester with links.

Strategic Priority #2: Enhance

What Are Our Goals?

1. Enhance internal communication.
2. Benchmark and elevate core library operations.
3. Foster a culture of continuous professional growth.

How Will We Do It?

- Communicate What We Do
 - Make an image that helps indicate how internal units interact and communicate.
 - Ensure job descriptions match actual duties and library needs.
- Keep Everyone In-The-Know
 - Create a centralized repository for all team members to access documents (e.g., policies & procedures, meeting notes).
 - Create a list of all internal policies & procedures.
 - Update/create prioritized policies & procedures we need.
- Know Ourselves
 - Define how we will assess ourselves.
 - Gather data.
 - Ensure all service areas are tracking data appropriately.
- Comparisons
 - Compare ourselves to peer institutions.
 - Launch two areas of improvement based on comparisons.
- Invest in Ourselves
 - Establish professional mentoring program within the library.
 - Give departmental presentations so we all know what each other does.
 - Report all completed professional development opportunities.

Strategic Priority #3: Sustain

What Are Our Goals?

1. Steward library resources efficiently and effectively.
2. Enhance access to library resources via technological innovation.

How Will We Do It?

- Fiscal Planning
 - Publish annual operational needs report.
 - Publish annual historical spending and projected spending.
- Collect Data on Collections
 - Get ready to collect data from tools.
 - Look at what peer institutions are doing.
 - Update collection development policies.
 - Create and revise policies in Special Collections & University Archives.
- Assess Partners & Contracts
 - Create list of current partnerships and contracts.
 - Publish needed information on vendor contracts (e.g., ERM).
 - Recommend ways to increase equity in partnerships.
- Create an Institutional Repository
 - Prepare a budget proposal.
 - Prepare a tentative implementation timeline.
 - Draft needed policies (e.g. usage, submission, and collection policies).
- Move to a new ILS (integrated library system)
 - Prepare a budget proposal, for an ILS.
 - Prepare a tentative implementation timeline.
 - Complete needed training.
- Refresh Our Digital Resources
 - Launch redesigned, updated library website.
 - Update all library database listings on library website.
