3. Meeting Minutes for the First Meeting: All QEP Committees (1/30/2024)

- Kye started the meeting, welcomed everyone and gave a brief overview and summary of the QEP 2020-2023 Comprehensive Review and Current QEP Status. Kye reviewed the status of the goals of the QEP and where we are in meeting those goals. This being the final year of the QEP, new committees have been created to ensure the successful conclusion of the QEP.
- We are currently on Year 4 of the QEP, Year 5 will include the writing of the QEP impact report, which, along with the SACSCOC 5th Year Interim report, will be turned in on March 1, 2025. New success initiative has been piloted; an online evening homework help as well as new flyers being created for each of the Math Pathways. New QEP branded merchandise has been ordered for final promotion of QEP for the rest of Year 4 and beginning of Year 5.
- New QEP subcommittees have been created or reorganized, including: The QEP Leadership, Assessment, Marketing/Outreach, Advising, Faculty/Student Support, and Writing Committees.
- Kye reiterated that the QEP impact report will be due March 1, 2025, and the writing of the report will be done mainly by the 3 members of the of the QEP writing committee. Kye said that the goal of the QEP wasn't to "end" after 5 years but to continue on as a program. Theresa informed the group that SACSCOC no longer requires a brand new QEP, but we can refine/refocus an aspect of the current QEP to propose for the next QEP.

- Brandi Palmer stated that the entire math department is on board with getting students in the correct math courses and pathway.
- Kye informed the group that each committee will need to schedule monthly meetings and the chairs of each committee will meet as a group in mid-late April.
- Where do we go from here? We need to improve QEP visibility. New pop up banners are an idea to put in the library and Setzer Center. QEP will have a table at Cardinal View.
- Jackie reminded the group she still has QEP branded merchandise as well.
- Along with the new Faculty and Student Support Committee, Kye also send out a survey regarding faculty and staff support last semester and will work on summarizing that information and relay it to the committee.
- The meeting adjourned so the subcommittees could break out and schedule their monthly meetings.
