# **Good of the Order:** One guest speaker attended today's meeting: **Dr. Alicen Flosi, Director of Sustainability**

Dr. Flosi discussed how important sustainability (Recycling) is on campus and in the world that we live in every day. She mentioned the following recycling-related information as follows.

- A lot of items are recycled for example, light bulbs (Lowes), ink cartridges, cell phones (Best Buy), aluminum cans, and flat non-stained cardboard boxes.
- Items that <u>should not be recycled</u> are shrink wrap, Solo cups, tape, liquids, food packaging like chip bags, gift bags, pet food with glossy finish, and styrofoam.
- Lamar has a recycling goal to reach 15% by year 2020, and currently we are at 10%.
- Currently, the Beaumont community recycled items are sorted by hand, and there is a monthly charge to receive a blue recycling bin to begin recycling efforts.
- Lamar University custodians receive training on how to successfully sort recycled items received daily on campus. All recyclable items must be put in green bags and nonrecyclable items should be placed in black bags.
- All shredded paper can be recycled if placed in green bags, and the Humane Society can
  use shredded paper as well at the animal shelter.
- Always remember when recycling items "When in Doubt, Throw it Out"!
- Lamar University has over 300 green recycle collection bins strategically placed around campus for recycling convenience. Also, there are about 12 green containers across campus that were made using recycled items.
- Lamar University has 2 on-campus gardens, and anyone can volunteer to work the gardens.
- Earth Day is April 22<sup>nd</sup> on the LU Dining Hall great lawn from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.
