Presentation was done by Larry Acker of the Public Relations Office about the Identity Guidelines (using logos, mascots, and seals) of Lamar University. There are two types of logos, Institutional (Star) and Athletic (Mascot, Big Red and interlocking LU). If you don't have the website, you can go to the main Lamar page and click on Administration, Advancement, Public Relations and then Identity Guidelines. The website shows all the different representation of either Institutional or Athletic logos. It tells the size of the logo, what can be part of the logo, how best to use it and how not to use the logos. The Lamar seal is only used on items that have a long shelf life, such as diplomas, certificates, and plaques. All of the logos have a File which shows the PMS (Pantone Matching System) Number. Each company that deals with Lamar has these numbers; the colors consist of LU white, red and black. The mascot will have LU green and yellow. From the website, you can choose which File that you want. Also, the website has the proper usage of the logos on letterhead, envelopes and forms.
