Did you know that?

In Fall 2017:

- 81 students participated in LU Success and 78% returned for more than one appointment
- 100% of the LU Success participants surveyed reported that they would recommend the service to another student and that they developed new strategies to help them reach their academic goals
- More than 600 students utilized Tutoring Services, including 108 students who attended Supplemental Instruction (SI)
- REDtalks averaged almost 10 students per workshop and 100% surveyed reported that they would attend another REDtalk
