- v. Fall 2021 Initiatives/Updates
  - 1. Would like to create a Dining Committee
    - a. If you are interested in being a member please reach out to Dining Services
  - 2. A new TV is being installed in the Dining Hall (in the carpeted area) students will be able to hold meetings in that space and utilize the TV
  - 3. Looking into possibly having a contract with Subway so students can use their dining dollars to purchase food this initiative is in its early stages

### vi. Questions:

1. Q. Would it be possible to play cable on the TVs (i.e. football games)?

- a. A. To do this a cable subscription would be needed but

  Dining Services is currently looking into ways to extend

  digital services (i.e. digital menu, cable in Dhall, etc.)
- 2. Q. What were the other food replacement options for Jason's Deli, besides Smoothie King?
  - a. A. Smoothie King has been in the contract for a couple of years now, even before Mr. Boyd started working here
- 3. Q. What happened to the food truck?
  - a. A. It has been down due to COVID but Dining Services is currently looking into ways to get it running in the Fall and ways to enhance the experience (i.e. increasing the number of food trucks)
- 4. Q. Is the Dining Services Committee open to all students?
  - a. Yes, it is open to all students

# vii. Suggestions:

- 1. Park the food truck near the dorms during later hours
  - a. This would attract more students as there is currently only one food option available to students after 9 PM
- 2. Implement a meal exchange program
  - a. Would allow students to use a dining swipe to buy a meal instead of dining dollars

# viii. Concerns:

- 1. There are not many food options available during later hours
  - a. A. Hours have been extended at The Market but there would need to be more foot traffic on campus to extend hours at other food places

#### **b.** General Student Concerns:

- i. As a result of graduation ceremonies getting canceled, students are not being given the graduation regalia they deserve
  - 1. The Academic Excellence Ceremony was canceled and students were not given any graduation regalia
    - a. Suggestion: Could hold a virtual (or prerecorded)
       ceremony to honor the students; the students could pick
       up their regalia themselves (or possibly have it shipped to them)
  - 2. Phi Kappa Phi has not inducted any students in the past couple of semesters, even if they met the requirements
  - 3. There is currently no graduation regalia for Presidential (Mirabeau) Scholars
    - a. The Scholarship Office will be talking with their
       Director to see what can be done
